Luckily the pandemic is receding and restrictions are being eased. Mask wearing is still encouraged if not actively playing. The club will follow all applicable City and Public Health guidelines.

Regular club activities will be reinstated this season, including drop-in play in the mornings (Monday to Friday and Sunday), Friday evening drop-in, monthly Sunday socials, junior activities, lessons, as well as competitive leagues (STF and Toronto) and both OTA and club tournaments.
