Here is the email that most of you are waiting for. The City has confirmed that community tennis clubs in Toronto are allowed to open tomorrow under strict guidelines. The guidelines are attached. They are very similar to the ones we played under last year. Right now both singles and doubles play is allowed.

We shall be using the same booking system that we used last year. Drop in play is not allowed. Guests are not allowed. Please only book one hour of play between 6.00 pm and 9.00 pm from Monday to Friday, as these are the most popular playing hours. Wear a mask when you come and go and follow social distancing guidelines. The clubhouse will remain closed for the time being.

Please bring your own hand sanitizer bottle. Although we provide hand sanitizer bottles for both the front and back courts, they are constantly being damaged. I don't know whether players press too hard on the dispensing hook or whether it is the squirrels and racoons trying to get the fluid out, thinking maybe that it is something nice to eat or drink.
